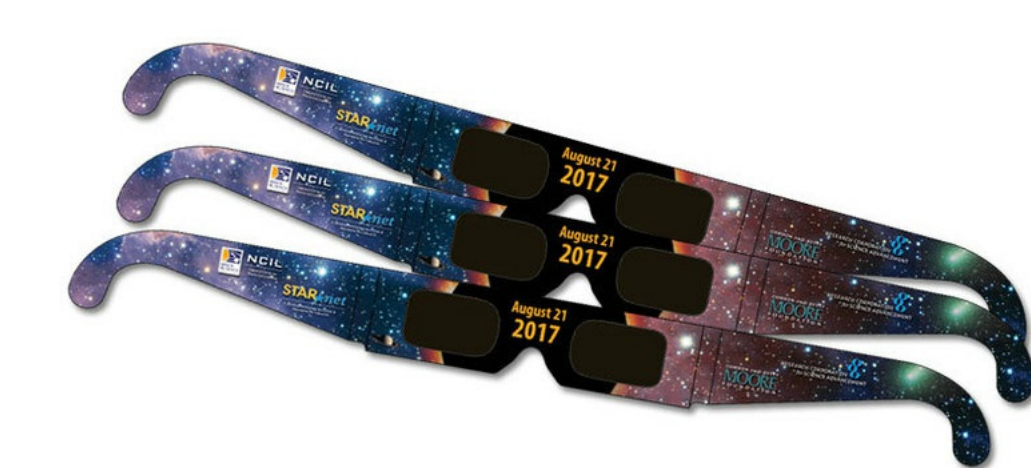

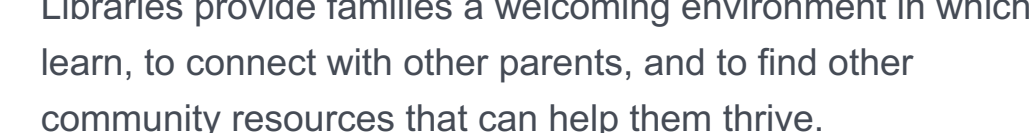

Participants become artist explorers as they use elements of art — line, color, texture, shape, and value — to analyze Earth, Mars, moons, or other worlds.

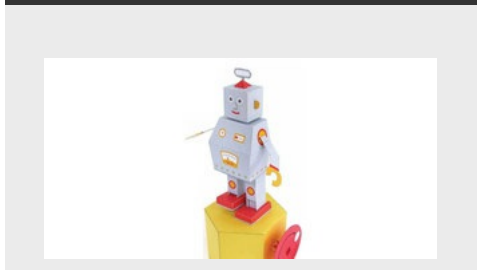

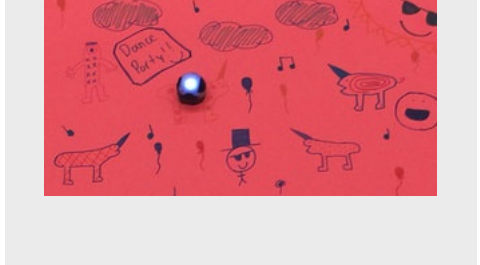
