- Must be 16 by July 13, 2019.
- Have a strong interest in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math.
- Ability to complete on-line requirements prior to the on-site intern program.
- Must be US citizen.

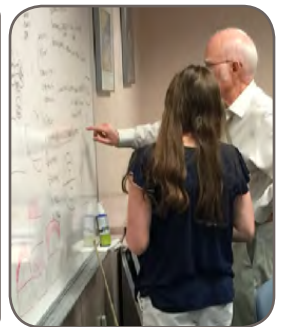
- Work with NASA Subject Matter Experts
