



Game Instructions

Object of the Game:

Participants will be able to characterize objects in our Universe, and be encouraged to contemplate their properties.

Ages:

Pre-K (with help) to adults

How to Play:

- Both players pick a card from the deck and place it in the slot on their side of the board, being careful not to let the other player see
- Each player takes turns guessing characteristics of the other players object
- The first player to correctly guess the other players object, wins!
Note: If a player guesses incorrectly, the other player gets 2 guesses on their turn

Hints:

- Ask a question that will eliminate as many objects as possible. For example "is it a moon" is a more useful question than "is it our moon"
- Think about categories of objects. Such as planets, objects outside our Solar System, objects with moons, etc.
